RESOLUTION NO. 2000 - 15

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE ESTABLISHING A PROVISIONAL APPROPRIATION LIMIT

WHEREAS, Article XIIIB of the California Constitution and Government Code section 7910 require a city to establish its appropriations limit for each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the provisional appropriations limit for the City of Elk Grove for fiscal year 2000-2001 was established by the Sacramento Local Agency Formation Commission in Resolution No. LAFC 1207, at paragraph 9.m., as part of the incorporation process; and

WHEREAS, the provisional appropriations limit as set forth in Resolution No. LAFC 1207 was confirmed and approved by a majority vote of the electorate as part of the ballot proposition for the proposed reorganization in accordance with Article XIIIB, Section 4;

WHEREAS, a permanent appropriations limit will be set by the voters of the City of Elk Grove at the first municipal election, which will be held following the first full fiscal year of operation by the City of Elk Grove;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Elk Grove that the City's provisional appropriation limit as required by Article XIIIB of the California Constitution shall be \$22,040,000.00
