

## RESOLUTION NO. 2000-55

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE REGARDING CLAIMS AGAINST THE CITY OF ELK GROVE


WHEREAS, throughout the course of civic events within the City of Elk Grove, the City will be involved in claims brought against it and will itself bring claims; and

WHEREAS, claims of sufficiently small size should be handled administratively by the City Manager, or a designee of the City Manager;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that:

1. All claims against the City of Elk Grove or any officer or any employee thereof shall be filed with the Clerk of the City of Elk Grove and processed in accordance with the applicable state law and this resolution;
2. Pursuant to Section 935.4 of the Government Code, the City Manager or said manager's designee shall be authorized to accept, settle or reject, without prior approval of the Council, claims against the City, provided that no allowance, compromise, or settlement shall exceed \$10,000.00 (ten thousand dollars);
3. The City Manager or said manager's designee is further authorized to compromise or settle, without prior approval of the Council, except on a matter of policy, any actions in which the City is the plaintiff, provided that the amounts of such compromise or settlement shall not exceed \$10,000.00 (ten thousand dollars);
4. Upon the written order of the City Manager or said manager's designee, the Director of Finance shall cause to be issued a warrant upon the treasury of the City in the amount for which a claim has been allowed, compromised or settled.


