

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-17

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE,
CALIFORNIA, RELATIVE TO SERVICES AND REIMBURSEMENT COSTS TO
SACRAMENTO COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF VOTER REGISTRATION AND
ELECTIONS FOR ELECTION CONSOLIDATION**

The City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove, California has adopted an Ordinance for the purpose of consolidating the City of Elk Grove general municipal election with the November statewide general election to be effective upon approval of the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove, California, hereby requests the Board of Supervisors of Sacramento County, or an officer of the County otherwise authorized by law, as prescribed by Elections Code Section 10402, to order the consolidation of each City of Elk Grove general municipal election with the November statewide general election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove, agrees to reimburse the Sacramento County Department of Voter Registration and Elections for actual costs incurred for each such election, such costs to be calculated by the proration method set forth in the County's current Election Code Allocation Procedures on the basis of the amount of services provided to the City. Services provided by the Sacramento County Department of Voter Registration and Elections in each such election shall include all administrative costs, procurement of election supplies and materials, and reporting of official election results.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove, hereby requests that whenever possible, the Sacramento County Department of Voter Registration and Elections appoint residents of the City of Elk Grove to the precinct boards within the City for each such election.

The City Clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
