A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE 2002 STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City Council of Elk Grove desires to provide the best transportation system possible for the citizens of Elk Grove, and

WHEREAS, the completion of the reconstruction of the Sheldon Road/State Route 99 freeway interchange is one of the primary means of providing a good transportation system, and

WHEREAS, the resources available to complete this project are under funded by \$7,300,000.

The City Council approves and authorizes an application for funding in the amount of \$7,300,000 from the 2002 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for the State Route 99 at Sheldon Road Interchange Project, and directs staff to submit the completed application to the Sacramento Area Council of Governments and the Sacramento Transportation Authority.
