

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-101

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
SECOND EXTENSION OF THE INTERIM AUTHORITY FOR
THE IMPOSITION OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING FEES**

WHEREAS, the City Council on May 15, 2002 adopted an urgency measure as interim authorization for a fee or charge to ensure that adequate affordable housing is provided for the residents of the City of Elk Grove, and established a fee for the provision of affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, the interim authority adopted on May 15, 2002 shall have no force or effect 30 days after its adoption; and

WHEREAS, the City Council may by resolution extend the interim authority for an additional 30 days.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Elk Grove that the interim authority for the imposition of fees in the City of Elk Grove (hereinafter "City") for affordable housing adopted on May 15, 2002, and on June 5, 2002 the City Council took action to extend the interim fee for an additional 30 days. The action taken by the City Council will expire after 30 days and is hereby extended an additional 30 days through and including August 15, 2002.
