**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF ELK GROVE INITIATING A ZONING AMENDMENT APPLICATION FOR
APN 119-0161-005**

WHEREAS, On June 5, 2002, the City Council directed staff to process a rezone of the property designated in the Multi-Family Housing Sites Analysis as "Multi-Family Housing Site #9", APN 119-0161-005 from RD-20 to RD-5; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is the appropriate authority to initiate a zoning amendment in accordance with Section 115-11 of the Zoning Code; and


WHEREAS, initiation of a zoning amendment application is not considered a project requiring review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); and

WHEREAS, the request to rezone the property would not be detrimental to the health, safety, peace, morals, comfort, or general welfare of persons residing or working in the neighborhood:

HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**


1. Initiate a zoning amendment application to rezone a site from Multi-Family Residential (RD-7) to Single Family Residential (RD-5).
