RESOLUTION NO. 2002-39

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR THE PROCESSING OF AN INITIATIVE PETITION FOR ANY MUNICIPAL MEASURE

WHEREAS, §9202(b) of the Elections Code of the State of California authorizes the City Council to establish a fee not to exceed two hundred (\$200) for the purpose of processing an initiative petition:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to § 9202 (b) of the Elections Code of the State of California, the City Council establishes a fee of \$200 dollars to be paid to the City Clerk by any person at the time of filing a notice of intent to circulate an initiative petition in the city.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk is directed to deposit any fees collected pursuant to this resolution into the general fund of the city. The fee will be refunded to the filer if, within one year of the date of filing the notice of intent, the Clerk certifies to the sufficiency of the petition.
