**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF THE FY 2001-2002 TRANSPORTATION
DEVELOPMENT ACT (TDA) CLAIM TO THE SACRAMENTO AREA COUNCIL OF
GOVERNMENTS (SACOG)**

WHEREAS, the state of California enacted the Transportation Development Act (TDA) in 1972 to provide funds for transportation needs each fiscal year; and


WHEREAS, the Sacramento Area Council of Government (SACOG) is designated as the Transportation Planning Agency for the City of Elk Grove to receive claims for approval pursuant the TDA rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, SACOG has adopted funding of apportionment for Local Transportation Funds for Fiscal Year 2001-2002; and

WHEREAS, after transportation needs have been met, any unused funds may be used for street and road improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the attached Fiscal Year 2001-2002 TDA Claim be hereby approved and forwarded to SACOG and that the Director of Administrative Services is hereby authorized to make the necessary budget amendments, transfers, accounting entries, etc. to carry out the City Council's policies and directives related to this matter.
