RESOLUTION NO. 2004-45

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO LEVY STORM DRAINAGE FEES FOR SCHULER RANCH UNITS 1 & 2

WHEREAS, by its Ordinance No. 22-2003, adopted on June 18, 2003 (the "Ordinance"), the City Council (the "Council") of the City of Elk Grove (the "City") reaffirmed the levy of storm drainage fees imposed by the County of Sacramento on lands within the boundaries of the City that were included within Zone 12 of the Sacramento County Water Agency on June 30, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the owner(s) of property identified as Schuler Ranch, Units 1 and 2, descriptions of which are attached hereto as Exhibit A, have requested the Council to make the property subject to the storm drainage fees levied pursuant to the Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Elk Grove as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Recitals</u>. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and this Council so finds and determines.

<u>Section 2</u>. <u>Declaration of Intention</u>. This Council hereby declares its intention to levy the storm drainage fees described in the Ordinance on the property described in Exhibit A.

<u>Section 3</u>. <u>Notice of Public Hearing</u>. On Wednesday, May 19, 2004 at 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, at City Hall, 8400 Laguna Palms Way, Elk Grove, California, the City Council shall hold a public hearing on the levy of the storm drainage fees.

<u>Section 4</u>. <u>Publication and Mailing of Notice and Ballot</u>. The City Clerk is directed (i) to publish a notice of the hearing in <u>The Elk Grove Citizen</u> twice in a ten-day period with at least five days intervening between publications (per Government Code §6062a) and (ii) to mail a notice of the public hearing together with a ballot by first-class mail, postage prepaid, to the owner(s) of the property upon which the fees are proposed to be levied. The notice of the hearing shall be in the form attached hereto as Exhibit B. The ballot shall be substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit C. The mailing shall be completed by March 31, 2004, which is at least 45 days before the date of the hearing.</u>

<u>Section 5</u>. <u>Effective Date</u>. This resolution shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.



CITY OF ELK GROVE NOTICE OF HEARING ON PROPOSED STORM DRAINAGE FEE

FOR SCHULER RANCH UNITS 1 AND 2

<u>Hearing</u>. Notice is hereby given that on Wednesday, May 19, 2004, at 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, at the City Hall, 8400 Laguna Palms Way, Elk Grove, California, the City Council of the City of Elk Grove shall hold a public hearing on the proposed levy of fees on Schuler Ranch to pay for the cost of storm drainage services.

<u>Storm Drainage Fee</u>. The amount of the proposed fee is based on each parcel's proportional share (based on the amount of stormwater runoff from the parcel) of the cost of operating and maintaining drainage facilities. The fees are calculated as follows:

1. A single-family residential parcel shall pay a monthly charge equal to the administrative charge + (unit service charge (USC) \times 3,500 \times each residential dwelling unit).

2. All other non-exempt parcels shall pay a monthly charge equal to the administrative charge + (parcel area x USC x the impervious factor).

The unit service charge shall be \$0.001583 per square foot of impervious area. The impervious factors shall be based on the following table:

Property Category	Impervious Factor
Commercial/office	0.80
Industrial	0.70
Multi-family residential	0.60
Institutional	0.50
Low impervious development	0.10
