

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-093

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE ON-CALL CONCRETE SERVICES – INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF CURBS, GUTTERS, SIDEWALKS, AND RELATED ITEMS PROJECT (OM2405); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH MCE CORPORATION FOR THE PROJECT BASED ON RATES AND SCOPE OF SERVICES IN THE BID; AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR OR AUTHORIZED DESIGNEE TO ISSUE WORK ORDERS UNDER THIS CONTRACT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNT BUDGETED FOR THIS WORK THROUGH THE ANNUAL BUDGET PROCESS; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH THE SECOND LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER IF THE FIRST LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER DOES NOT MEET FILING OBLIGATIONS (CEQA EXEMPT)

WHEREAS, the On-Call Concrete Services – Installation, Maintenance and Repair of Curbs, Gutters, Sidewalks and Related Items (OM2405) (Project) includes installing, removing and replacing concrete sidewalks, curbs, gutters, driveways, ADA access ramps, including adjacent hot mix asphalt (HMA) pavement, root removals, installing detectable warning surface (DWS), and other related items as directed by the Public Works Director, or authorized designee; and

WHEREAS, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on April 19, 2024, and April 26, 2024, and electronic bids were received on May 14, 2024; and

WHEREAS, MCE Corporation was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, Central Valley Engineering & Asphalt, Inc. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the second lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, the Project is a project under California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA), which requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

WHEREAS, the quantities listed for each work task are approximate and not guaranteed; therefore, the Public Works Director or authorized designee shall have the authority to amend quantities or tasks for the duration of the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Finds the On-Call Concrete Services – Installation, Maintenance and Repair of Curbs, Gutters, Sidewalks and Related Items (OM2405) exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301 (existing facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines based upon the following finding:

Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving the minor alteration of existing

public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use. This Project involves removing and replacing concrete sidewalks, curbs, gutters, driveways, ADA access ramps, including adjacent hot mix asphalt (HMA) pavement, root removals, installing detectable warning surface (DWS), and other related items as directed by the City. As the proposed improvements will occur to existing City-owned public infrastructure and right-of-way, and will not result in an expansion of use, the Project qualifies for the identified exemption and no further CEQA analysis is required; and


- 2) Approves the Project; and
- 3) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with MCE Corporation for the On-Call Concrete Services – Installation, Maintenance and Repair of Curbs, Gutters, Sidewalks and Related Items (OM2405) based on rates and scope of services in the bid, upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney; and
- 4) Authorizes the Public Works Director or authorized designee to issue work orders under this contract in an amount not to exceed the amount budgeted for this work through the Annual Budget process; and
- 5) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with the second lowest responsive bidder, Central Valley Engineering & Asphalt, Inc., if, MCE Corporation does not meet filing obligations.
