A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE APPROVING THE 2024 PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE PROJECT – SLURRY SEAL AND PAVEMENT RESURFACING (WPR024); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH PAVEMENT COATINGS CO. FOR THE PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,700,817; AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT-TO-EXCEED \$470,082 (CEQA EXEMPT)

WHEREAS, the 2024 Pavement Maintenance Project – Slurry Seal and Pavement Resurfacing (WPR024) (Project) includes placing slurry seal, micro-surfacing, two layer treatment system, adjusting utility frames and covers, and re-striping various streets throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, an invitation to bid was duly advertised on April 19, 2024, and April 26, 2024, and electronic bids were received on May 16, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Pavement Coatings Co. was determined to be the responsible bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, the Project is a project under California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA) which requires that cities consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

WHEREAS, the Project is included in the approved Fiscal Year 2023-28 Capital Improvement Program and is budgeted with funds in the approved Fiscal Year 2023-24 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

1) Finds the 2024 Pavement Maintenance Project – Slurry Seal and Pavement Resurfacing (WPR024) exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301 (existing facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines based upon the following finding:

Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving the minor alteration of existing public or private facilities when the alteration involves negligible or no expansion of an existing use. This Project involves placing slurry seal, microsurfacing, two layer treatment system, adjusting utility frames and covers, and re-striping various streets throughout the City. As the proposed improvements will occur to existing City-owned public infrastructure and right-of-way, and will not result in an expansion of use, the Project qualifies for the identified exemption and no further CEQA analysis is required; and

2) Approves the Project; and

- 3) Rejects the bid protest submitted by VSS International, Inc., and finds the lowest bid submitted by Pavement Coatings Co. to be both responsible and responsive and waives any minor irregularities in Pavement Coating Co.'s bid, if any.
- 4) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Pavement Coatings Co. for the 2024 Pavement Maintenance Project Slurry Seal and Pavement Resurfacing (WPR024) in the amount of \$4,700,817 upon receipt of all required bonds and insurance and the approval of such bonds and insurance by the City Attorney; and,
- 5) Authorizes the Public Works Director to approve change orders not-to-exceed \$470,082; and,
