

**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-149**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE  
DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK  
GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.180(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH R.C.A. INVESTMENTS, INC., DBA  
LONG BEACH BMW MOTORCYCLES, A CALIFORNIA CORPORATION FOR THE  
PURCHASE OF FOUR REPLACEMENT PURSUIT-RATED POLICE MOTORCYCLES  
FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$182,000**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Elk Grove's Fleet division maintains all City vehicles and procures replacements and additional vehicles when necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's Fleet division has identified four Police motorcycles that will have reached the end of their useful life of City service in Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-25, and

**WHEREAS**, the State of California opened a competitive bidding process for the purchase of pursuit-rated BMW Police motorcycles; and

**WHEREAS**, Long Beach BMW Motorcycles, a California corporation, was awarded the State of California's large quantity contract for pursuit-rated Police motorcycles, which was competitively bid and Long Beach BMW Motorcycles will honor such state-contract pricing in sales of motorcycles to the City; thus, the City is receiving a competitive price and the expenditures of staff time and money to compile the necessary bid documents a second time for a small number of motorcycles will not likely result in a better price or an outcome more advantageous to the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:


- 1) Dispenses with the formal bidding procedures for the subject motorcycles pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(B)(3) and authorizes the purchase of the subject motorcycles pursuant to the terms and conditions of the competitively-bid State of California Contract #1-22-23-30; and
- 2) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract with Long Beach BMW Motorcycles, in substantially the form presented, funded as referenced in Table 1 of the staff report, for the purchase of four new replacement pursuit-rated BMW Police motorcycles for a total compensation amount not to exceed \$182,000.
