A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS FOR THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE GRANTS AS ELIGIBLE THROUGH FY 2027-28 THROUGH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES RECYCLING AND RECOVERY (CALRECYCLE), AMEND THE RECYCLING AND WASTE BUDGET EQUAL TO THE GRANT AWARD RECEIVED AND EXPENDED EACH YEAR, AND TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO SECURE AND IMPLEMENT THE GRANT AND GRANT-RELATED REPORTS TO CALREYCLE

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 48000 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various grant programs (grants) in furtherance of the State of California's efforts to divert household hazardous waste generated in the state thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health, safety, and the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Recycling and Waste Division utilizes CalRecycle's Local Government Household Hazardous Waste grant funds for a variety of collection events, improvements, and education and outreach initiatives, depending on the grant cycle guidelines, to promote proper and safe disposal of household hazardous waste; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants.

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove authorizes the City Manager to:

- 1) Submit applications for Local Government Household Hazardous Waste Grants as eligible through FY 2027-28 through CalRecycle.
- 2) Amend the Recycling and Waste budget equal to the grant award received and expended each year.
- 3) Execute all documents necessary to secure and implement the grants and all related reports to CalRecycle.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this authorization is effective until rescinded by the Signature Authority or this Governing Body.
