A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.140(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CALIFORNIA ELECTRONIC ASSET RECOVERY (CEAR) FOR TRANSPORTATION AND RECYCLING SERVICES OF UNIVERSAL WASTE AND ELECTRONIC DEVICES COLLECTED AT THE SPECIAL WASTE COLLECTION CENTER FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS WITH THREE OPTIONAL ONE-YEAR EXTENSIONS FOR A TOTAL COMPENSATION AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$220,000 AND TO EXECUTE FUTURE AMENDMENTS AND ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY FOR CONTINUED SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove's Special Waste Collection Center (SWCC) collects universal waste and electronic devices from residents of Elk Grove and partnering jurisdictions and has a need for proper collection and recycling services, pursuant to state and federal guidelines; and

WHEREAS, California Electronic Asset Recovery (CEAR) has been contracted for collection and recycling services for universal waste and electronic devices, and has provided consistent and reliable service to the City since the SWCC opened in April of 2014; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code 3.42.140(A), the City issued a formal request for proposals (RFP) on June 27, 2018, for transportation and disposal services for universal waste and electronic devices collected at the SWCC; and

WHEREAS, CEAR was again deemed highly qualified to perform the requested services and was selected as the vendor to perform services; and

WHEREAS, CEAR is a known leader in the universal waste and electronic device recycling industry, is a local vendor, and has provided collection and recycling services at the SWCC for the last ten years; and

WHEREAS, staff are highly satisfied with CEAR's customer service and changing vendors would impact SWCC operations, including the potential for increased costs and decreased levels of service while onboarding a new service provider; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons presented, a formal request for proposal procedure is not in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Dispenses with the formal request for proposal procedure pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.140(B)(3); and
- 2) Authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with California Electronic Asset Recovery (CEAR), in substantially the form presented, for transportation and recycling services of universal waste and electronic devices collected at the Special Waste Collection Center for an amount not to exceed \$220,000; and

3) Authorizes the City Manager to execute future amendments and additional documents necessary for continued electronic and universal waste transportation and recycling services, provided the total cost does not exceed amounts budgeted for these services in the annual Citywide budget process, which Annual Budget is subject to City Council approval.
