## **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-192**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE DISPENSING WITH THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCEDURE PURSUANT TO ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.42.180(B)(3) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH READY2GO RESTROOM TRAILER SALES LLC FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN ADA+2 RESTROOM/SHOWER COMBINATION TRAILER IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$85,000

WHEREAS, the City of Elk Grove's Fleet division maintains all existing City vehicles and procures additional vehicles when necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is opening a year-round shelter facility providing temporary housing for Elk Grove residents experiencing homelessness; and

**WHEREAS**, the selected facility does not have available restrooms and showers to support up to 35 residents plus staff members; and

WHEREAS, to assist with the assessment of equipment needs to support the shelter facility, staff contacted distributors to find either a new or used ADA+2 Trailer, in stock, and available for immediate delivery. Staff contacted Rich Specialty Trailers (who only manufacture trailers for retailers), Jag Mobile Solutions Satellite Industries and CT California Trailers (who didn't have trailers in stock), Ready2Go (which has a new trailer available) and Portable Restroom Trailers, LLC (which has a used trailer available); and

**WHEREAS**, considering these factors, staff found the new trailer provided by Ready2Go to be the best value to the City; and

WHEREAS, American Cargo Group (ACG), was awarded Sourcewell's large quantity contract for trailers with related equipment accessories and services, and Ready2Go is the distributor of ACG units under a contract that was competitively bid and Ready2Go will honor such contract pricing in sales of trailers to the City; thus, the City is receiving a competitive price and the expenditure of staff time required to compile the necessary bid documents a second time for a single trailer will not likely result in a better price or an outcome more advantageous to the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Elk Grove hereby:

- 1) Dispenses with the formal bidding procedures for the subject trailer pursuant to Elk Grove Municipal Code Section 3.42.180(B)(3) and authorizes the purchase of the subject trailer pursuant to the terms and conditions of the competitively-bid Sourcewell Contract #092922-AGO; and
- 2) Authorizes the City Manager to execute a contract with Ready2Go, in substantially the form presented, for the purchase of one new Americans with Disabilities Act+2 Restroom/Shower Combination Trailer for a total compensation amount not to exceed \$85,000.
