

ORDINANCE NO. 25-2003

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE
REPEALING CHAPTER 16.120
OF THE CITY OF ELK GROVE MUNICIPAL CODE
RELATING TO DEFERRAL OF RESIDENTIAL IMPACT FEES**

The City Council of the City of Elk Grove does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this ordinance is to repeal Chapter 16.120 of the City of Elk Grove Municipal Code in order to eliminate the authority to grant deferrals of certain development impact fees, so that impact fee revenue is collected as soon as possible.


SECTION 2. REPEAL. Chapter 16.120 "Deferral of Certain Residential Impact Fees," of the Elk Grove Municipal Code is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage.

SECTION 4. PUBLICATION. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption. In lieu of publication of the full text of the ordinance within 15 days after its passage, a summary of the ordinance may be published at least five days prior to and fifteen (15) days after adoption by the City Council and a certified copy shall be posted in the office of the City Clerk, pursuant to GC 36933(c)(1).


